This is an easy to use customized 25 plus (district/school preference in terms of number and type of questions) question survey that may be given to staff, students and/or families. The data will include similar questions asked of each group with a comparison crosswalk.

We know that students, staff, and families are in challenging times and we are all in uncharted waters...Now is the time to gather this critical information, so we know where we are and what is needed.

PLC will provide a comprehensive set of questions from the areas of youth assets, social/emotional/developmental health, restorative practices, risk behaviors, equity, diversity, student relationships and connections... etc.

PLC will create the links, deliver your reports, and work with you to analyze results and plan.

The SEDH Climate Survey is an excellent instrument for establishing baseline, creating goals and monitoring progress in supporting students' needs in this critical area.
